## ***“Focus Intensive Internship”***

**Purpose:** The purpose of this focus intensive internship is to provide experience in treatment planning and facilitation of sessions using the Eagala model with a focus topic. The goal is to improve in the Eagala model through direct EAP/EAL client experience and to learn from others. This focus intensive internship gives you EAP/EAL hands-on experience in specific topical areas depending on the date for each day full of EAP/ EAL, treatment planning and education.

- Goals:**
- (1) Practice the basics of Eagala model with direct supervision
  - (2) Identify powerful messages horses communicate that provide valuable therapeutic information
  - (3) Equip mental health professionals and equine professionals with the skills needed to adjust to meet client goals
  - (4) Gain a further understanding of the spectrum of session variations necessary to meet different treatment goals depending on client demographics
  - (5) Learn to treatment plan and execute treatment goals in sessions
  - (6) Improve in using Eagala model through “hands on” practice with clients with various treatment goals

**DIRECTIONS:** From Best Western, Quality Inn, and Comfort Inn Hotels, take 87 South to 82<sup>nd</sup> Street exit. At light, turn left (east) under overpass on 82<sup>nd</sup> street and go approximately 1 mile until 82<sup>nd</sup> dead ends at Martin Luther King Blvd. Turn right (south) onto MLK Blvd. Go about a block and you will see the facility on your left. Turn in the driveway at the Refuge Services sign. Parking is on the north-side of the large barn.

**From Ashmore Inn and Hampton Inn** – take right out of parking lot onto frontage road. Take right on first street (right after church). Go to the light (82<sup>nd</sup> St.) and turn Left. Go to the end of 82<sup>nd</sup> (approx 4 miles) which runs into Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. Turn Right. Go about a block and you will see facility on your left. Turn in the driveway at the efuge Services sign. Parking is on the north-side of the large barn.
